It has come to the notice of the University that certain anti-social elements are circulating **false and fabricated claims** through WhatsApp, Telegram, and other social media platforms, alleging possession of the CNET-2026 question paper and offering to sell the same. The University **categorically and strongly denies** all such claims. These are deliberate attempts to mislead candidates, create panic, extort money, and undermine public confidence in the examination.

Candidates and parents are strongly advised to:


- NOT believe, engage with, or pay any money to anyone making such claims on any platform

- Remain calm and focused on their preparation — the examination will be conducted strictly on merit

Strict legal action shall be initiated against persons involved in fraudulent activities under the Information Technology Act, 2000, the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, and the Uttar Pradesh Public Examination (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 2024.
